1880: Annie lived with her brother, Dr. Thomas Crozier, and his family in Boston.

Edward and Annie Rand lived on the Henry Clay and Henry Seaton Rand estate in the house at 120 Elm Street next door to the main house at 112 Elm Street.

Death Date: May 12, 1921

Edward Lothrop Rand was apparently courting Annie Crozier as early as 1883:

Monday, Aug. 20 [1883]

Champlain Society Asticou Camp Log

"...After dinner Rand rowed to SW. Harbor. The others stayed at camp reading &c. Suddenly Rand appeared in their midst and ejaculated "Visitors"! Instantly the campers dispersed as if a bombshell had fallen in their midst. Spelman's flight did not cease till he was safe on the steps of Savage's. Bates and Jones timidly appeared later and exhibited themselves to the three visitors Miss Crozier, + Mrs. + Mrs. Adams. After the visitors had inspected the camp, Rand conducted them to Haddock's Pond, whence they did not return till dark. Rand then "assisted" them to row back to SW. and returned to camp in a cheerful mood about midnight..."

Note:

Asticou Camp, the second Champlain Society camp, was erected in "Captain Savage's field at the head of Northeast Harbor. Captain Savage was Augustus Chase Savage (1832-1911) who took rusticators in to board at his home there, Harbor Cottage, later known as Cranberry Lodge, built

Description: Annie Matilda Crozier was born in 1856 to Thomas and Mary (Shattuck) Crozier, probably in Ireland. Annie's father was a pianoforte manufacturer from New Brunswick, Canada. The family lived in Charlestown, Massachusetts. Annie became a schoolteacher and lived with her brother, Dr. Thomas Crozier, and his family in Boston in 1880. Photographer Henry L. Rand's brother, the naturalist Edward Lothrop Rand, married Annie Matilda Crozier on June 29, 1893 in Boston, Massachusetts. Annie Matilda (Crozier) Rand died on May 12, 1921.
