Edward Lothrop Rand was apparently courting Annie Crozier as early as 1883:

Monday, Aug. 20 [1883] Champlain Society Asticou Camp Log

"...After dinner Rand rowed to S.W. Harbor. The others stayed at camp reading &c. Suddenly Rand appeared in their midst and eja culated "Visitors"! In stantly the campers dispersed a sif a bombshell had fallen in their midst. Spelman's flight did not cease till he was safe on the steps of Savage's. Bates and Jones timidly appeared later and exhibited themselves to the three visitors Miss Crozler, + Mrs. + Mrs. Adums. After the visitors had in spected the camp, Rand conducted them to Hadlock's Pond, whence they did not return till dark. Rand them "assisted" them to row back to S.W. and returned to camp in a cheerful mood about midnight..."

## Note:

Asti cou Camp, the second Champlain Society camp, was erected in "Captain Savage's field at the head of Northeast Harbor. Captain Savage was Augustus Chase Savage (1832-1911) who took rusticators in to board at his home there, Harbor Cottage, later known as Cranberry Lodge, built
