"C.E. Clements' boat shop at Clark's Point has been a busy place all winter and work is now rushing to be ready for summer. Mr. Clement has built a forty foot boat for Elwood Spurling with mahogany top and cabin. The craft has a toilet and lavatory and electric lights and will be chartered for private use for the summer.

Henry E. Sheffield of Deer Isle has had his boat rebuilt and made three feet longer and it has received new finish and paint. A boat for Milo W. Wilder of New Jersey is about finished. This boat is 32 feet long. Several new engines have been installed. Early in the winter Mr. Clement built over a 54 foot cruiser (or Mr. Sinclair of Northeast Harbor Summer colony. He also built a tender for Mr. Lippincott of the same summer resort and has done much work on boats from Cranberry Island. Mr. Clement is taking down the gasoline house on the water end of his wharf and plans to build a store with show room and office in its place. He will carry engines, supply parts of engines, marine hardware and outfits." - Bar Harbor Times, April 20, 1927.
