This accession is a large collection of photographs of people, boats, or scenes from the Southwest Boat company (SWB) between the 1980s until the early 2000s. Most photos are of boats being launched into the water, worked on at a shop, or driving in the water. Locations range from Southwest Harbor to Arizona. Much of the information in this index was taken from notes written by Charlotte Morrill.

The photos are each in a wax paper envelope with the index number in the upper right corner. Items 097 and 098 are each in a regular paper envelope with the index number written on the front upper right.

2006-005	Barge or float being constructed in 1988, built for David Rock Jr, project led by Steve and Bob Watkins
2006-006	Three men working near the fly bridge of a SWB push boat in Kansas City on the Missouri River
2006-024	Photo of the Wiscasset, design BD-3, built by SWB and Woodin & Marean being lowered into the water in Washington D.C.
2006-025	SWB push boat being launched in 1983, probably designed by Watkins or Wallsdeck
2006-026	Unpainted boat being launched in Rockland, ME. McLoon Co. tanker visible to the left
2006-027	Unpainted boat being launched, labelled W-Z Stinson
2006-038	64' aluminium boat "Columbia Point," owned and operated by UMass Boston docked in the water circa 2003-04
2006-042	Col. Point, a boat built by Winninghoff in Rowley, MA and finished by D.H. Kelley in Fairhaven, MA
2006-051	"Fermesin" in the SWB doorway, built by Ted Delehanty
2006-052	26' patrol boat built by Jhanson, Bianchi, Frederic (JBF), designed by Bob Watkins, circa 1990-91
2006-053	Twin keel sailboat designed by Bruce Roberts in 1988. SWB was hired to construct the aluminium hull
