Sawtelle was born and raised in Bangor, Maine. He graduated from MIT where he later taught
physics and began his scientific research. Sawtelle and his wife became permanent residents of the
Cranberry Isles in the early 1920's. In 1925 friends Robert Abbe, Charles W. Eliot, and George B.
Dorr encouraged Sawtelle to form the Islesford Collection Inc. to house his ever expanding
collection. In 1926 construction was began and in 1928 the museum opened its doors. Sawtelle
never named his museum and did not want it named after him. Acada National Park named it the
